Our Pastor's Perspective

Meditation has been a Christian discipline for a long time and I am no expert at it, but have found it helpful in keeping me more balanced and counteracting a tendency to let my anxiety levels get out of hand. Most of us type A's, especially Methodist with our desire to match our actions in Social Holiness with our beliefs in Scriptural Holiness tend to focus on what we can do to make things better. This mindset often causes us to focus on the future or on our past experiences so that we can avoid making future mistakes. The problem with that, is we often don't focus on the joy of the now. I believe that God wants us to be happy. What parent doesn't want their children to have happiness, contentment and joy in their lives. Meditation is often defined as the acceptance and focus on the now. For me it means taking time to focus on the blessings of God that are presently in front of me: Things like listening to our bodies as they function; feeling the warmth of a warm blanket or a hot shower as it pours over us; thinking about our spouses and our children and the special times and love they and we have shared with each other and are sharing. The simple blessings in the now are what meditation brings to a new reality. It is not in seeking the things that make you happy by planning and focusing on the future, but by focusing on the happy blessings of the now. Physiologists and neuroscientists have discovered in recent studies that meditating on a regular basis can rewire our brains in positive ways. It helps fight addictive behaviors, depression and letting the problems that surround us overwhelm us. It brings back the balanced feelings of joy that counter the negative stresses in our lives. We, as Christians, have one reality that stands out as the most important blessing we can dwell upon at any time in the now. That is the blessing of a creator that loves us and wants to live in us and through us in lives of joy. The Bible is the greatest love letter ever written. There are many scriptures we can focus on in the now that have the potential to revive our spirits. So as one of God's representatives in the church, I would highly recommend meditation, as a means, to recover joy, contentment and hope in our lives. Especially meditating on Christ our real and living God that is always with us. Maybe this is a good one to start with John 3:16).
